I understand that my mare must be examined by a licensed veterinarian with an ultrasound machine at about 14 and about 50 days after the last breeding day. Confidento Partners will need to be notified of her pregnancy status at that time by phone or email so a breeding certificate can be issued after the breeding season, before foaling.

This contract cannot be assigned or transferred by Purchaser. There shall be no right of return to the Stallion if the Mare is sold or otherwise changes ownership after having been served by the Stallion unless otherwise stated.

In the event of stallion death or the inability to produce and ship viable semen from the stallion contracted for this service, "Farm" shall substitute this fresh semen agreement for either fresh or frozen semen any other Stallion owned by the "Farm".

In case the mare does not conceive, "Farm" guarantees return privileges for the contracted mare during the course of the breeding season (May15th- August 15th) and guarantees return breeding privileges for the two seasons following the initial breeding season (total of three years) to insure "Purchaser" that a foal is produced as a result. The Purchaser recognizes the Farm's right to require a negative intrauterine culture certificate before the Mare's return to service. A mare may be substituted with permission of the "Farm" and a statement from a licensed veterinarian confirming the original mare on contract is barren. This contract is only transferable upon approval with written permission of "Farm".

Live Foal Guarantee - If the Mare does not settle during the Present Breeding Season; if the Mare is examined in foal but becomes barren during gestation or if the Mare subsequently produces a live foal that is unable to stand alone and nurse within 72 hours of foaling, and subsequently dies, "Purchaser" shall be entitled to above-mentioned return privileges. This guarantee shall only apply if the "Farm" is notified within one week of the foal's death. In all cases, the required Veterinary Certificate shall affirm that the Mare had been immunized for equine rhino pneumonitis during pregnancy and the date of such vaccination. Where appropriate, the certificate shall also confirm that the Mare was properly cared for during gestation and was attended at foaling. The farm's timely receipt (within 10 days of examination) of the required Veterinary Certificates is a condition precedent to any right of return.

The "Purchaser" shall assume all responsibility for the condition of the mare and shall bear all risk of loss or damage to the mare whether by death, disease, injury, infection or otherwise, and by any cause whatsoever, and therefore agrees to hold the "Farm", owner, keeper or agent harmless for any and all damages associated with breeding and boarding the mare.

In the event of emergency, if a Veterinarian or Farrier is required for the mare or foal, services of the same will be provided by personnel used by Sigma Warmbloods and will be at Purchasers expense. Every effort will be made to contact the mare owner prior to any services being provided but failing to reach the mare owner, services will be contracted at the discretion of Sigma Warmbloods.
